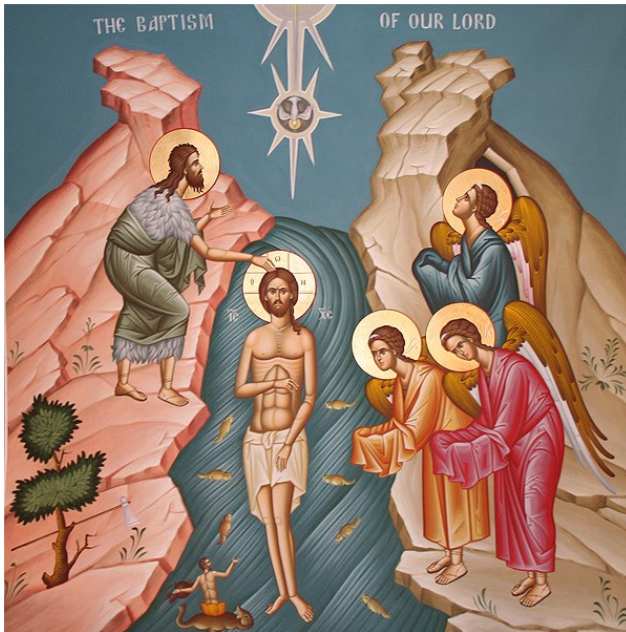

Theophany, sometimes called Epiphany, is upon us. The sixth of January is the official date that the baptism of Christ is celebrated in the Eastern Orthodox Church.

The word Theophany means “Revelation of God;” Theophany therefore marks the revelation of the Trinitarian nature of God when Jesus was baptized.
