- ◆ The annual Parish Beer Tasting is rapidly approaching! Please invite your friends so that we can be sure to make this years event a great success! The date for the Beer Tasting is set for October 11th, but the sooner we know how many people to expect the sooner we can properly prepare. Thank you for your support and God Bless!
- ◆ It has come to my attention that there is some confusion about the way in which to form a line to receive Holy Communion. I will try to make this as simple as possible so that we can not be distracted at this all important moment of the Liturgy. Starting from the front row to the back there should be two lines, one on the right side and one on the left. People should leave their row starting with those closest to the center isle. If you are on the in the middle or on the outside of the row you should move through the row towards the center isle. Once in the center each side should alternate, left-right, left-right, left-right, and so on. After receiving Holy Communion you should go back to your seat, going either right or left, depending on where your seat is. You should get back to your seat by going all the way to the outside and moving back through the row to wherever your seat is. Sorry if this is confusing!
